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Purpose	We would like to request access to the European Soil Database v2.0 - vector and attribute data for scientific and academic use. The data will be used within an ongoing research and mapping activity related to Natura 2000 sites in Bulgaria, in which our university is actively involved. The project focuses on the new delineation and assessment of Natura 2000 habitat zones, and the soil data are required to support the development of environmental indicators based on soil types for the proposed habitat areas. Specifically, the dataset will be used to: identify and classify soil types within proposed and existing Natura 2000 zones; support habitat suitability and characterization analyses; contribute to scientifically grounded decision-making in conservation planning. The data will be used strictly for non-commercial, research, and academic purposes, and all usage will comply with the licensing and citation requirements defined by the Joint Research Centre (JRC) and ESDAC.
