








# **Land Consumption / Land Take**

### **Objectives**

# ELSA is a platform and lobbyist for municipal soil conservation with the objectives of:

- Promotion of soil conservation activities at the local level
- Development and implementation of common projects and standards
- Exchange of information and experiences among members

**2015:** Peatland protection – a contribution to municipal climate protection






#### **Members**

# Declaration adopted by the political General Assembly of EUSALP

- in November 2018
- under Tyrolean EUSALP Presidency
- supported by 20 regions and 6 Alpine states


