Agri-Environmental Programme ÖPUL 2015

23 measures to promote an environmentally friendly, extensive and habitat-protecting agriculture

Contribution to soil fertility:

- Greening of arable land (intermediate crops and "evergreen" system)
- Direct seeding and seeding in mulch
- > Erosion protection in fruit, vineyards and hops
- Preventative surface water protection on arable land



Climate Alliance

Training Course on "Spatial Planning and Soil Protection"

- Organized in co-operation with municipalities
- > Participants are decision makers mainly from the communal level
- Lasting several days
- > Final reports include concrete projects







Eco-Social Forum

Soil Charta 2014

➤ Adopted by 10 partners

4 main targets:

- Awareness raising on soil protection
- Consider soil protection in large-scale projects
- Revitalization of inner cities
- Utilization of brown fields

 - > etc.






